## Innovation Grant

**Eligibility:** This grant is only available to teachers from Institutions within the United Kingdom.

**Description:** This grant is to help teachers to develop creative and innovative ways of incorporating soil science into lessons. The aim of this grant is to promote good practice in teaching soil science and to support teaching that is innovative, inspiring and intellectually stimulating. Money is available to enable teachers to develop and resource innovative teaching and learning activities and/or to undertake research to evaluate methods of teaching Soil Science. This can be achieved in many different ways and can include projects based in or outside of the classroom.

**Value:** up to £500

**Application Deadlines:** 1<sup>st</sup> April and 1<sup>st</sup> September

Applications for school grounds development will not be considered under this grant.

- The applicant needs to be in charge of the project and have full institutional support.
- A report on how the project progressed must be received no later than 6 months after the issue of an award.
- Published papers. Reports to other organisations etc. Should include an acknowledgement of the support from BSSS.
